Job description: The Patrol Leader is the elected leader of his patrol. He represents his patrol on the Patrol Leaders' Council.

Reports to: Senior Patrol Leader. If you are the patrol leader for the new Scout patrol, you will also work with the Troop guide who is assigned to your patrol.

Patrol leader duties:

- Plan and lead Patrol meetings and activities.
- Represent the patrol at all patrol leaders' council meetings and the annual program planning conference.
- Keep Patrol members informed, including summarizing the content of PLC meetings and sharing this information with the Patrol via email, immediately after each PLC meeting.
 - Copy the SPL and SM on all such communications and
 - Maintain copies of the 2-way communications with the Patrol that can be provided to the SPL and SM upon request in the event they are not copied on a message to the Patrol.
- Together with the support of your Patrol, lead one Troop activity during your time as Patrol Leader. This includes:
 - Preparing the Trip Plan for the activity
 - Assigning leadership responsibilities for the activity to members of your Patrol and work with them to fulfill their responsibilities and thereby successfully lead the Troop in the activity. Such responsibilities could include teaching Scout skills necessary for the activity in advance of the activity.
 - Leading the Troop in the activity.
- Prepare the patrol to take part in all Troop activities.
- Show and help develop Troop spirit.
- Work with other Troop leaders to make the Troop run well.
- Set a good example.
- Wear the Scout uniform correctly.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Show Scout spirit.

Requirements: All requirements must be completed to receive full leadership credit, otherwise only partial credit will be given. A registered adult leader or the SPL must initial requirements.
