- Assist the assistant Scoutmaster with training.
- Coach individual Scouts on Scouting challenges.
- Set a good example.
- Wear the Scout uniform correctly.
- Live by the Scout Oath and Law.
- Show and help develop Scout Spirit.

**Requirements: All requirements must be completed to receive full leadership credit, otherwise only partial credit will be given. A registered adult leader or the SPL must initial requirements.**
